Estate-grown, hand-picked, whole bunch-pressed with light solids in the ferment, kept on lees for 2 months. A wine of crystal clarity in every way and marries elegance with power as it unfolds. Lime and scaly acidity are intertwined on the exceptionally long and pure palate. Few '16 Rieslings from anywhere in Australia could point to the future as convincingly as this wine.

Pinot Grigio / Pinot Gris

Pinot Grigio hails from north-eastern Italy (predominantly the beautiful Veneto and Friuli regions) and is picked slightly earlier in the ripening season, making it a crisp and refreshing glass of vino. Pinot Gris, on the other hand, is elegantly Alsatian. It's richer, riper and silkier in texture, and so it's often a more smoother glass of wine.

Typically, it shows a pink grapefruit character, concentration and mid-palate texture, which reflect the carefully selected sites and hand harvesting during the small window of perfect ripeness. The 2017 vintage is true to style with accentuated florals and very bright natural acidity, leading to a fresh, aromatic and pure finish.

Hand-picked, chilled overnight, whole bunch-pressed, wild-fermented in new and used French oak, limited lees contact. Regarded by Julian Langworthy as the best yet, and it's easy to see why. Glinting straw-green; the palate is almost aching in its intensity and length, arcing through white peach, nectarine, grapefruit zest and mouthwatering acidity. The 2015 Reserve Chardonnay finish and aftertaste give a high fidelity replay of all that has gone before.

The Port Phillip Estate vineyard was planted in 1987 and acquired by the Gjergja family in 2000. Located in Red Hill, the ten hectare site is planted to Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Shiraz and Sauvignon Blanc, all on northerly and easterly-facing slopes. The viticulture and winemaking activities we practice are guided by a series of fundamental principles. Every vintage of Port Phillip Estate wine has been made from fruit that has been hand pruned, shoot thinned and hand harvested. Wherever possible, the use of chemicals in the vineyard has been replaced with a mechanical or cultural control method and we believe that continually improving our vine nutrition, vintage by vintage will continue to lessen our reliance on external inputs.
